¹H. Terris Neuman reviewed *Faces of Renewal* in the *Journal of the Evangelical Theological Society*, vol. 33 no. 4 (1990): 566-568. Neuman sees *Faces* as a reminder that the purpose of pentecostal scholarship is to serve the Church (568). He describes Horton as a good example of one who has done just that—employ "academic endeavor for the benefit of the Church" (566). He attributes the appearance of such a book in honor of a pentecostal scholar to the "place higher education has attained in the pentecostal movement" (566) and says it reminds us that the "place of the Spirit in the Church is worthy of study in the first-century and twentieth-century environments" (568).
